Vanderbilt University Brings New Downtown Campus



The City of West Palm Beach and the Board of County Commissioners recently took major steps to bring Vanderbilt University to downtown West Palm Beach. Vanderbilt presented their plans to build a 300,000 square foot graduate school campus focused on business, artificial intelligence (AI) and data science in West Palm Beach.

The City voted recently to donate 2 acres and the Board of County Commissioners directed staff to bring back a contract for providing county-owned land for the project by Oct. 8. An economic impact study has indicated that the new graduate school campus would generate \$7.1 billion in total economic activity. We congratulate the County and City Commissioners for quickly moving on this exciting project.

Palm Beach County Schools Receive an A Rating

Michael Burke, superintendent of the School District of Palm Beach County, was all smiles as he heralded the good news of the school district attaining an A rating for the 2023-24 school year at the Chamber's Back to School Breakfast on Tuesday, Aug. 6 at the West Palm Beach Marriott Hotel. This is Burke's fourth year as superintendent, and he credited the hardworking team of educators, administrators, students, parents and the community throughout the district that partnered to make Palm Beach County the best choice in education. In his stirring presentation, he shared many exciting innovative programs, such as Khanmigo (AI) and HUDL, innovative choice and career programs in arts, international baccalaureate, critical industry certifications, and immersive community experiences with community partners such as Mounts Botanical Garden, the Kravis Center for the Performing Arts and the Norton Museum.

At least six new high schools were completed during the period. The district is home to several state champions in soccer, bowling, weightlifting, track and field, and more, and is now the best community for music programs at the elementary and high school levels. Qualifications were enhanced throughout the various levels within the district and district, and with the Amplified

Mathematics Program (AMP)

starting at the elementary level. Palm Beach County Schools have strengthened their ability to successfully meet employment and economic needs in the years to come. In closing, Burke encouraged attendees to support and respond favorably to the ballot question about the one-half-cent tax, which is a tremendous help for schools in

the county. During the event, attendees generously donated school supplies to The Education Foundation Red Apple Supply Drive and more than \$1,800 to the Belvedere Elementary School. The utility powerhouse, Florida Power and Light Co., generously matched the amount raised by the attendees at the event bringing the total to more than \$3,600.
